
### **IMPORTANT - Installation site**


- 1. Ensure the top surface of the bath on which the bath screen will be installed is level in very direction.
- 2. The tiles or other wall finishing should be effectively sealed at bath edges.
- 3. Tiles should extend at least to the corner of the bath.
- 4. The screen can only be constructed in the hand that is specified on the box label. This instruction is showing the installation process for a LH screen.'

















**Step 1**: Position the wall profile (1) onto the bath, approximately 12-15mm from the outside bath edge to ensure that the screen runs along the inside edge of the bath rim.(A)

Step 2: Level the profile with a spirit level, then mark the position using a pencil,mark through the 3 pre-drilled screw holes in the wall profile then drill the marked points using a 6mm masonry drill bit.Once this is done insert 3 wall plugs(12).(B)


NOTE: You may find it easier to mark and drill the wall if you apply masking tape to it first.


**Step3 :** secure the wall profile using 3 x ST4X30 screws (13). (C)


**Step 4**: Carefully position the screen into the wall profile. (D)

Step 5 : Drill the holes in the wall profile through the vertical profile of the fixed panel using 2.75 drill bit (E), secure profiles together using the 3 x ST4X12(15) ,cover caps(14) and the screw cups(16).(F)

## Fitting The Support Arm & The Bath Channel Bottom Rail







- **Step 6**: Position the support arm(6) on the fixed glass panel, ensure that the arm is level and horizontal, mark the position on the wall.(G)
- **Step 7**: Remove the support arm then drill on the wall through the marked position using a 6mm masonry drill bit, then insert the wall plugs(12)(H)
- **Step 8**: Replace the support arm onto the fixed glass,attach it onto the wall using 2 x ST4X30 screws.(13)(I). Attach the glass clamp onto the fixed panel using the 2 x M8X6 grub screws.(J)
- **Step 9**: Place a small amount of silicon sealant onto the bottom of the bottom rail fixing cap A(9),bottom rail(10),and bottom rail fixing cap B(11),then secure them into position on the bath per diagram (K)
- Step 10 :Fit the top cap (2) onto the wall profile. (L)

# Applying Silicone Sealant Sealing Inside

Seal from the top of the wall profile to the bottom on the INSIDE between the wall profile and the wall

IMPORTANT:Do not apply sealant on inside of bath

### Sealing Outside

Seal only along the bottom rail and fixed glass on the OUTSIDE between the profile/glass and the bath. Also up between the wall profile and the wall.

### **Cleaning Instructions**

It is important to clean your Aquadart shower enclosure after every use. Please wipe down all glass and metal parts with a clean soft cloth. Ensure that all residual water on the glass is removed after every use.

### Usage

For reliable, watertight performance from your Aquadart enclosure your shower head should not be positioned so that the shower sprays directly onto the enclosure door. Failure to comply with this may cause the shower to leak. Outward opening doors may cause water to drip onto the floor, please ensure that the floor covering immediately outside the enclosure will not be affected by water.







This product has been treated with Clean & Clear<sup>™</sup> easy clean glass treatment, a protective barrier which creates a 'non-stick' surface on your glass, helping to resist lime scale build up and water spots.
